Awards Bid for Tax Bill Printing and Mailing Services to  
Financial Statement Services, Inc.**

SANTA ANA, CALIFORNIA (August 26, 2004) – The Orange County Board of Supervisors approved an agreement between the Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collectors (OCTTC) office and Financial Statement Services, Inc. (FSSI) for Tax Bill Printing and Mailing Services for a three-year term.

OCTTC department solicited bids from over one hundred and seventy eight vendors, of which ten bids went before the OCTTC RFP Evaluation committee. FSSI's bid was deemed the most competitive of the final contenders to meet all the OCTTC job specifications.

The OCTTC prints and mails approximately 1.3 million tax bills and notices annually. Orange County's property tax bills are currently printed by the County's Data Center and mailing services are provided by a mailing services vendor. With changing technology and improvement, OCTTC looked for a more cost effective single processing environment, which included designing, printing and mailing of tax bills, notices and inserts from a single vendor.

OCTTC provides efficient and effective investments, cash management and property tax collection services for the county, cities, special districts and school districts of Orange County.
